1. Announcement:

The Autumn Run will be held on Sunday 9th October 2022 and is organised by the VSMA. The event will start from the Carmichael Bistro & Tearoom and will finish at the Moffat House Hotel. Food, hot and cold is available to buy at the start.

The entry fee will include a light afternoon tea at the finish venue.

2. Jurisdiction:

The event will be held under the general rules of the Motorsport UK as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. A Motorsport UK Touring Assembly Permit has been applied for.

3. Eligibility:

The event is open to all members of the Veterans of Scottish Motorsport Association. If not already a Member, Membership can be paid along with entry. Annual Membership is £20 per person.

4. Vehicles:

The event is open to the following:

a) Cars manufactured before 1980

b) Sporting cars of any age

c) Any other cars permitted at the discretion of the organisers. Cars constructed before 1980 will be given preference for entry.

5. Entry List:

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form. The entry list will close on Monday 3rd October 2022.

6. Documentation:

Pre event document inspection and signing on will take place from 10.00am within the Carmichael Bistro. The event will start at 11.30am and you will be given your start time in the final instructions.

7. Scrutineering:

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration to say that they have the following :-

a) A valid MOT certificate, if applicable.

b) A valid Road Fund Licence.

c) A minimum of Third-Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

d) Crews are recommended to carry Safety vests, Warning Triangle, and oil spillage / splash mat.
Cars must comply with the Motorsport UK regulations for the event.

8. Route and Navigation:

The route which will be approximately 85 miles, will be on public A and B class and unclassified roads and will all be on sealed surfaces. The route will be supplied after inspection of documentation and signing on prior to the start. The route instructions will be in the form of a road book with Tulip Diagrams showing junctions going from "ball to arrow".

9. Responsible Driving:

Participants must always comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Please remember other road users, motor cyclists, cyclists, walkers, and livestock. NOTE 20mph speed limits through villages. Quiet roads are designated walking and cycling routes and have a 40-mph speed limit.

10. Entries:

The entry fee is £30 per car or £20 per single crewed car. This includes the road book and a light high tea at the finish venue.

All entries must be made on the entry form and accompanied by the appropriate entry and membership fee if applicable. Maximum number of entries is 40. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. The minimum number of entries is 20. Email entries will be accepted, as will direct bank transfer payment. Details on the Entry Form.

A finishers award will be presented to all entrants completing the route and reaching the finish venue.

13. Insurance:

Participants are responsible for ensuring that all drivers of vehicles entered in the event are fully covered by insurance during the event as required by the Road Traffic Acts and will be required to sign a declaration to that effect at the start. All crew members will also be required to sign a declaration at the start on the signing on sheet indemnifying the organisers and Motorsport UK from liability.

14. Data Protection Act:

Prospective entrants and competitors are advised that information supplied on the entry form will be held on a computer and used for the administration of the event.
